Important Safety Instructions

Read Carefully Before Use: Prior to operating the equipment, thoroughly read and understand this instruction manual to ensure safe usage.

Adhere to Safety Rules: To prevent injury, fire, and electrical shock, strict adherence to the main safety rules for using any electric appliance is mandatory.

Proper Equipment Maintenance: Equipment maintenance includes thorough cleaning before and after each use in accordance with the instructions outlined below.

Power Supply Requirements

Ensure the equipment is connected to the power supply mains with the correct voltage and current through a grounded socket, following the specifications above.

Safety Guidelines:

- 1. **Disconnect Before Maintenance:** The heater must be disconnected from the electric power mains before any maintenance activities.
- 2. **Avoid Contact with Hot Surfaces:** Exercise caution as the equipment heats up during operation. Do not touch hot surfaces with bare hands.
- 3. **Special Precautions:** Take special precautions when the heater is left unattended, used by children, or in their presence.
- 4. **Disconnect During Maintenance:** The heater should be disconnected from power mains between operation cycles and prior to cleaning or maintenance. Press the switch button and unplug the equipment from the electrical socket.
- 5. **Prohibited Use with Faulty Components:** Do not operate the heater with a faulty power cable, plug, or if it has been damaged. Unserviceable heaters should be examined or repaired by an authorized service centre.
- 6. **Usage Environment:** Avoid using the heater outdoors or in highly humid areas. Ensure it is placed on a stable surface to prevent tipping or contact with water.
- 7. **Electrical Socket Grounding:** The electrical socket connecting the heater to the mains must be grounded. Do not use extension cables or lay power cables under carpets in high-traffic areas.
- 8. **Proper Plug Usage:** Use the provided 3-pin plug only in a suitable three-pin hole socket. Do not modify the plug or attempt to connect it to a two-pin hole socket.
- 9. **Installation Precautions:** Install the heater on a non-flammable surface to mitigate the risk of fire.
- 10. **Environment Restrictions:** Do not use the heater in rooms with flammable materials such as gasoline or paints.

Pre-Starting Procedure

Equipment Setup: Install the equipment on a flat, horizontal surface.

Lamp Insertion: Insert a lamp with the specified power as indicated on the Specifications.

Operation Guidelines

- 1. **Power Connection:** Plug the power cable into a grounded socket to connect to the electric mains with the required voltage. Ensure proper grounding to avoid electric shock.
- 2. Food Placement: Place food pieces on a dish directly under the lamp for optimal results.
- 3. **Shutdown:** Turn off the heater upon completing the operation.
- 4. **Disconnection:** To disconnect the heater from the electric mains, press the switch button and unplug the equipment.

Equipment Cleaning

Note: Proper maintenance can enhance efficiency and prolong the equipment's service life.

Before cleaning, disconnect the equipment from the electric mains and allow it to cool down.

Clean the equipment using a sponge, first with a neutral soapy solution and then with water. Wipe it dry.

Do Not: Wash the heater with a water jet or immerse it in water or other liquids.
